

## **Science Awards\***

**Best Overall Paper (Roscoe E. Miller Award)** – The best oral scientific paper presented in the main scientific sessions.

**Top GI Paper** – The best GI oral scientific paper presented in the main scientific sessions.

**Top GU Paper** – The best GU oral scientific paper presented in the main scientific sessions.

**Top Technical Innovation Paper** – The best technical innovation oral scientific paper presented in the main scientific sessions. Eligible topics include but are not limited to: technology, novel imaging sequence development, reconstruction technique, or unique applications of artificial intelligence/machine learning.

**Next Frontier Award** – The best oral scientific paper presented in the main scientific sessions not meeting criteria for a Technical Innovation Paper. Eligible topics include, but are not limited to: quality and safety, contrast, health services research and practice management topics.

**Top Trainee Paper (Alexander R. Margulis Award)** – The best oral scientific paper submitted and presented by a trainee in the main scientific sessions. Eligible trainees include: undergraduates, medical students, residents, fellows, non-clinical graduate students and research fellows. (\$500 monetary award).

**Emerging Investigator Award\*\*** - In the event that none of the above science awards are won by an early career investigator (presenting author who meets SAR criteria for early career [within 7 years of post-fellowship training]), the scientific committee may award an Emerging Investigator Award to the next eligible oral scientific paper presented by an early career member.

## **Power Science Session Award**

**Top Power Science Paper** – The best power science oral scientific paper submitted and presented in the power science (clinical fellow) category. (\$300 monetary award).

\* Papers are only eligible for a single award tier and category. Individual presenters may receive multiple awards in different categories.

\*\* This may or may not be awarded in a given a year.
